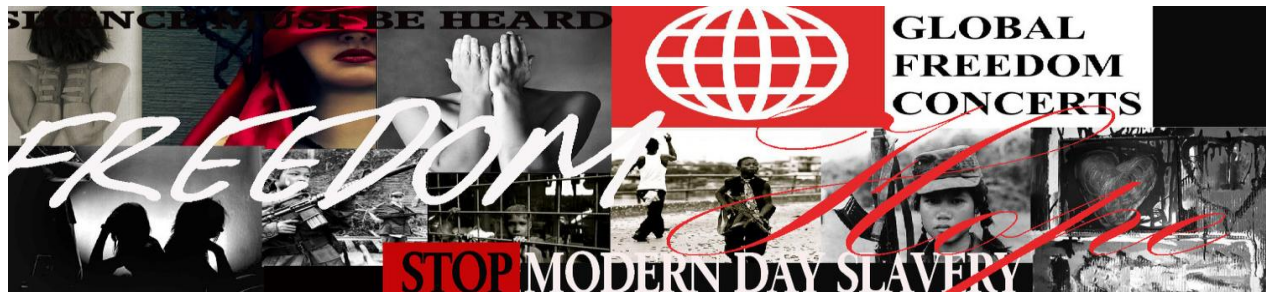

**There are an estimated 27 million slaves, with some used for forced labor and as child soldiers, but the great majority are women and children who are violently exploited sexually. These women and children are bought and sold as property and live under abuse, violence and sexual exploitation.**

- About 18,000 women are trafficked into the USA annually.
- About 50,000 children are kidnapped and trafficked annually in the USA.
- California is one of four states in the USA with the highest number of human trafficking.
- The four largest human trafficking centers are Los Angeles, San Francisco, San Diego and Orange County.
